# CHILDREN FRAMING CHILDHOODS: REVISIONING CARE IN EDUCATION AND SOCIETY

PROFESSOR WENDY LUTTRELL, CUNY

In this seminar Wendy Luttrell will speak about her book, *Children Framing Childhoods: Working-Class Kids' Visions of Care* that amplifies children's perspectives on the centrality, salience and ways of seeing (and not seeing) care. The book was published in January 2020 and within weeks, a global pandemic would force a long-needed public reckoning with care inequality and injustice. Professor Luttrell will reflect on how the twin pandemics of COVID-19 and systemic racism (in its multiple manifestations) make the book all the more relevant for considering new visions of care in education and society.
