UCD Geography PhD Scholarship Terms and Conditions

- The scholarship consists of a fee waiver (but no stipend) to the value of EU fees for the relevant academic year.
- The scholarship will normally be available for a maximum of four years.
- Recipients may be offered opportunity to participate in tutoring at undergraduate level though this will be subject to agreement with the PhD supervisor and the Director of Teaching and Learning. This tutoring will be paid at agreed hourly rates.
- Recipients are encouraged to find alternative sources of funding once they have established themselves onto the programme in Year 1. They must apply to the Irish Research Council PhD scholarship scheme (or an equivalent) in Year 1, (if appropriate to their PhD project), which provides a full scholarship (tuition and stipend). If they are successful in gaining this or alternative funding, the UCD Geography PhD Scholarship will cease.
- Payment of the scholarship is dependent both on good standing within the university and satisfactory performance and progress. This will be determined by the Doctoral Studies Panel (DSP) in consultation with the Director of Graduate Studies.
- If for any reason the scholarship holder is unable to continue with their academic studies at UCD, they must inform their PhD supervisor and the School Office immediately and submit a formal withdrawal application without delay.
