



## ACCE

### Summary of electronic meeting of 22 July 2021

1. ACCE approved the minutes of the meeting of 24 June 2021.
2. ACCE approved the Summary Notes from the meeting on 24 June 2021.
3. ACCE noted that the 2020/21 ACCE Annual Report would be circulated for members' comments before submission to Academic Council.
4. ACCE noted the eThesis team met with the Medicine research team (faculty and administration) for a session on eThesis issues and assistance.
5. ACCE noted that all committee members have confirmed they will continue with ACCE membership following re-appointment.
6. There were no ACCE Declarations of Potential Conflicts of Interest.
7. ACCE noted that they were awaiting acknowledgement for a request to submit a revised report for an MD degree in the School of Medicine with the ACCE approved recommendation for Revise thesis and submit for re-examination.
8. ACCE approved an Active Affiliate as Intern Examiner for Research Degree Examination Committee for School of Chemical and Bioprocess Engineering.
9. ACCE noted an update from Governance and Secretariat Officer-minor editorial change that has been made to the Academic Regulations, for implementation from Sept 2021. In respect of assessment for research programmes, the word 'corrections' has been replaced with 'revisions' throughout .
10. ACCE reviewed a BDIC Paper with Protocols and Guidelines on the involvement of Undergraduate students in assessing other Undergraduates.
11. ACCE noted Exceptional Change of Grades approved by ACCE sub-committee (*Total Accepted for Spring Trimester 2021: 56*).
12. ACCE noted a Change of Examination Committee Chair.
13. ACCE reviewed eThesis reports and approved awards of research degrees for DEdPsy in the College of Social Sciences and Law (*no. of candidates approved: 2*).
