

Note on Some Types of Actions Funded by Horizon Europe

Research and Innovation Actions (RIA)

- Funding for research projects tackling clearly defined challenges, which can lead to the development of new knowledge or a new technology
- Applies to consortia of partners from different countries, industry and academia
- Funding rate: 100% of eligible costs

Innovation Actions

- Funding is more focused on closer-to-the-market activities. For example, prototyping, testing, demonstrating, piloting, scaling-up etc. if they aim at producing new or improved products or services
- Applies to consortia of partners from different countries, industry and academia
- Funding rate: 70% of eligible costs (except for non-profit legal entities, where a rate of 100% applies)

Coordination and Support Actions (CSA)

- Funding covers the coordination and networking of research and innovation projects, programmes and policies. Does not cover funding for research and innovation per se
- Applies to single entities or consortia of partners from different countries, industry and academia
- Funding rate: 100% of eligible costs

Marie Skłodowska-Curie Actions

- Funding for international research fellowships in the public or private sector, research training, staff exchanges
- Applies to early-stage researchers or experienced researchers (of any nationality), technical staff, national/regional research mobility programmes
