Major Structure Review Checklist



Taught Majors

1) Refer to the <u>Structures by Major</u> report on the <u>Structures Reporting</u> menu on InfoHub, select 'click to view' under the 'Excluding CRNs' column for the relevant major/stage and check the following items:

- Credits: combined core/option credits for each stage match the 'Credits' field in the 'Summary Information' section
- Stage text: stage text for each stage has been recorded correctly in the 'Details' field in the 'Summary Information' section
- Credit Split by Trimester: complete this field for modules that span more than one trimester
 & consider workload implication. Zero credits must not be recorded for any trimester
- Student Workload: students must not be required to take more than 30 credits per trimester*
- Option rule text: correctly describes the number of modules students need to take. Refer to the section below on option rules.

Undergraduate Majors only

- Electives: 25 elective credits across all stages*
- o Additional Options: available for students who don't want to take electives
- Stage 1: 30 core and option credits are available in Autumn* (additional options cannot be used to make up to 30 credits)

2) Use the <u>Structures Check - Majors Missing Data</u> report on the <u>Structures Reporting</u> menu to check that:

- There are no inactive modules on any major
- There are no majors without a structure
- There are no option rules without any modules

Reviewing your Option Rules Set-up

Rule Type: 'MIN OF' Rule / 'Minimum of x' Rule

- Students must take the minimum number of modules recorded in the 'No required' field
- For example; a MIN 1 OF rule indicates students must take at least one module from the list, meaning there must be more than 1 module in the list for them to take
- A MINOOF* rule means students can choose modules from that list but are not required to do so
- *MINOOF should be used to offer students additional option modules as alternatives to electives

Rule Type: 'OF' Rule'/ 'Select x of' Rule (1 OF/ 20F etc)

- o Students must take the exact number of modules recorded in the 'No required' field
- Note that a '0 OF'* rule means students will not be able to choose modules from the list in that option rule and should not be used
