## Introduction

Quiz results are set to auto-publish once a quiz has been completed; you can disable this or modify what displays when a student submits, or even set a date in the future for release of correct quiz responses.

## Method

- 1) Navigate to the relevant quiz within your module and open the quiz settings using the **Edit** option. Within the settings, go to the **Evaluation & Feedback** section in the right-hand panel.

## Evaluation & Feedback

Auto-publish attempt results immediately upon completion

**2)** If you do not want the results to auto-publish (such as if you have quiz questions that require manual grading, for example the short or long answer questions), you can uncheck the **auto-publish attempt results immediately upon completion** box.

Alternatively, if all the quiz questions are auto-graded and results are to be released upon completion, leave this box checked and you then need to choose what will be displayed to students when they submit their quiz.

- 3) Further down this section, under the heading **When published, display to learners**, the **Attempt grade** is also automatically selected. Uncheck this if you wish to keep this hidden from the students.
- 4) The dropdown underneath that then determines what information is shared with the students upon completion of the quiz, from nothing at all (**No questions**), to questions answered incorrectly, with or without the correct answers, to all questions, with or without the correct answers.

When published, display to learners:

Attempt grade

and

No questions

- Incorrect questions only, with correct answers
- Incorrect questions only, without correct answers
- All questions, with correct answers
- All questions, without correct answers

## Customise Quiz Results Displays

Additional view comes into effect:

Display Date \*

A limited amount of time (in minutes) after submission

Your work has been saved and submitted

Custom Message

Grade

Display attempt grade for evaluated questions

Questions

Show the correct answers to the displayed questions

Show the learner's responses to the displayed questions

Show the learner's grade for the displayed questions

- Under the **Display Date** heading, choose a date and time when you want the information selected in this window to become available to students.

This allows you to automatically release additional information *after* the students have submitted their quiz at a set date. This might be useful if you have a quiz running asynchronously within a window of time, to release the correct quiz answers to the

students after the window for completing the quiz has passed.

- The **Custom Message** text box allows you to add an accompanying message with the release of the additional information.
- The **Questions** dropdown has a number of options, similar to those under **When published, display to learners** heading on the main quiz settings page, allowing you to show students all questions or only those they answered correctly or incorrectly.

If you had set **No questions** on the main quiz settings page, here you have the option to release all correct responses, along with the student's responses.

- Finally, the **Statistics** heading has check boxes to display the **class average** or **grade distribution**, if you wish.

**7)** When you have made all the appropriate selections within this section, click **Create** and then **OK** to close the window and return to the main quiz settings page.

**8)** Complete all other quiz settings and select **Save**.
