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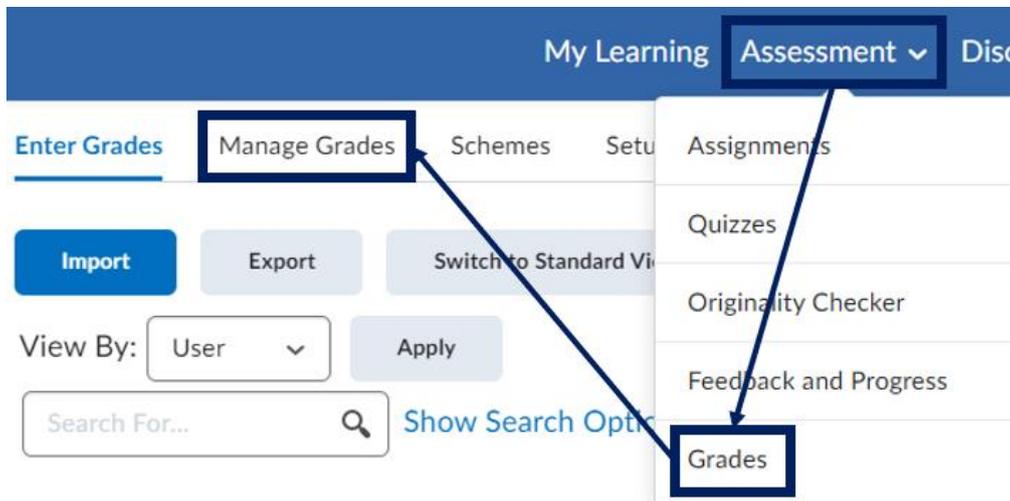
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Introduction

If you have a number of assignments created, and require students to complete some or all of them, but only wish to assess their highest scores, you can create a 'best x of y' grade category to drop the lowest grade(s) from the grade calculation.

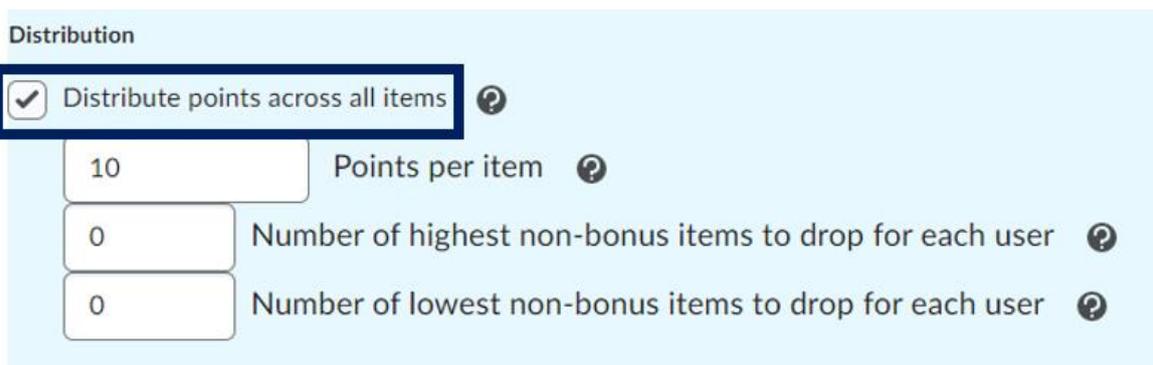
Method

- 1)** First, within your module, create all the individual assignments to be included, [each with a grade item attached](#). Ensure each of your assignments have the same maximum points assigned so the total score will be the same regardless of which grade is dropped.
- 2)** Then, navigate to **Assessments > Grades** and select the tab for **Manage Grades**.



3) Select the **New** button, and then **Category** from the dropdown.

4) This will open a new page; give the category a name and scroll down to the **Distribution** section. Here, check the option to **Distribute points across all items**.



5) This will then make the options within this section available to edit; update the **Points per item**. This will set the number of points that will be assigned to each grade item within the category. Ensure this is consistent

with the maximum points (**Score Out Of**) that you set for each of the individual assessments.

6) Next, select how many assignment scores to discard in the overall calculation. For example, if you are setting up a 'best 2 of 3' arrangement, where students can complete two separate quizzes/assignments out of a total of three, you will select 1 for **Number of lowest non-bonus items to drop for each user** i.e. exclude the lowest score of the three assignments from calculation.

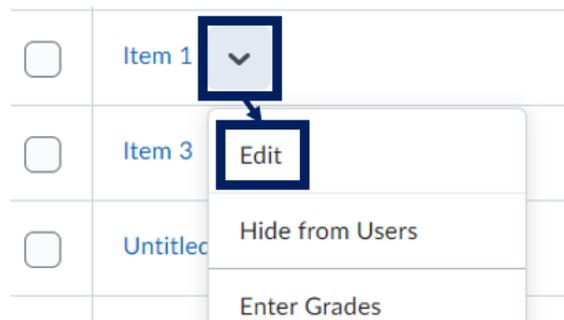

7) Select **Save and Close**.

8) This will return you to the **Manage Grades** section. You will then need to add the relevant assignments to this newly created category; navigate to the first grade item in the **Manage Grades** section that you wish to add to the category and select the **downward arrow** beside the grade item name and then select **Edit**.



9) This will open a new page with the grade item's settings; scroll down to the **Category** section and use the dropdown to select the one you had created.

10) Select **Save and Close**.

11) Repeat for each of the assignments to be included in the category. They will display under the category heading on the **Manage Grades** page once they have been added, so you can easily see the members of the category.
